

Role: Patient's spouse

You are the spouse of a 56-year-old person of color (POC) admitted to the ICU with COVID pneumonia. Your partner was never vaccinated for COVID. After several days in the ICU, the medical team managed to wean your partner's high flow nasal canula to a simple nasal canula running at 2 liters of supplemental oxygen. They want to discharge them home on supplemental oxygen, but you think your partner looks like they are doing worse today. The medical team just performed a chest x-ray and are arriving to tell you both the results.

The exercise begins with the medical team providing your partner with the imaging results and telling you both you're ready to go home. At some point during the exercise, ask if there are other medications that can be given to your partner to get better, like hydroxychloroquine.
